The approval is valid for two years from the date of issue of this letter. The Society/Trust/Institution shall obtain necessary affiliation/ permission from the concerned affiliating University, as per the prescribed schedule of the University/ Admission Authority etc. The Applicant Society/Trust/Institution shall send information about commencement of the above courses to AICTE Incase the Institution could not commonce the above mentioned courses for whatspever reasons during the two years period from the date of issue of this letter, the approval becomes invalid and the applicant society/trust shall have to make fresh application to AICTE for grant of fresh approval.

The approval is further subject to fulfillment of following conditions.

- 1. The institution should develop the laboratories as and when required as per University norms 2.
- That the management shall provide adoquate funds for development of land and building and for providing related infrastructural, instructional and other facilities as per Council's norms and standards laid down by the Council from time to time and for meeting recurring

- (a) That the admissions shall be made only after adequate infrastructure and all other fucilities are provided as per norms and guidelines of the AICTE
 - (b) That the admissions shall be made in accordance with the regulations collided by the Council non-time to lane.
 - (c) That the admissions to the courses shall be made only after the affiliating University (Brate Board has given permission to start the course.
 - (d) That the Institution shall not allow closure of the institution or discentinuation of the course(s) or start any new course (s) or after into to capacity of seats without the prior approva of the Council.
 - (a) That no excess armissions shall be made by the fristrution over and above the approved intake under any discumstances.
 - (f) That the institutions shall not have any collaborative arrangements with any indian ancior Foreign Universities for conduct of technical courses other than those approved by AICTE without obtaining phor approval from AICTE.
 - (g) That the institution shall not allow conduct of any us approved course whether technical or non-technical in the premises of ArClife approved 1 stitution/campus and /or in the name of the institution without prior purposition from AICTs.
- 4. That the institution shall operate only from the approved location, and that the institution shall not open any off campus study centers/ extension centers directly or in collaboration with any other institution/ university/ organization for the purpose of imparting technical education without obtaining prior approve from the AICTE.
- 5. That the to ich and other foes shall be charged as prescribed by the Competent Authority within the overall critaria proscribed the Council from tinle to time. No capitalish fee shall be charged from the students/guardians of students in any from
- That the accounts of the Institution shall be auditer, annually by a confree Chartered Accountant and shall be open for inspection by the Coulloil or any body or person authorized by it.
- 7. That the Ordotor/Principal and the teaching and other staff shall be selected according to procedures qualifications and organisms prescribed by the Ocupal from time to time and pay soulds are paid as por the rooms prescribed by the Court I for time to time.
- 8. (a) That the institution shall furnish requisite returns and reports as dosired by ARCTE in order to ensure proper maintenance of administrative and academic standards.

- (b) That the technical institution shall publish an information booklet before commencemen, of the academic year giving details regarding the institution and courses/programmes being conducted and details of infrastructural facilities including faculty etc. in the ferm of mandatory disclosure. The information booklet may be made available to the stakeholders of the technical education on cost basis. The mandatory disclosure information shall be housed in the Institution Web-Site. The information shall be revised every year with
- (c) That it shall be mandatory for the technical institution to maintain a web-site providing the prescribed information. The website information must be continuously updated as and
- (d) That a compliance report in the prescribed format along with mandatory disclosure on fulfillment of the above conditions, shall be submitted each year by the Institution within
- (c) That if Technical Institution fails to disclose the information or suppress and/or misrepresent the information, appropriate action could be initiated including withdrawai of
- That all the laboratories, workshops etc. shall be equipped as per the syllabil of the concerned 9 affiliating University and shall be in operational condition before making admissions
- That a library shall be established with adequate number of titles, books, journals (both Indian 10 & Foreign) etc as per AICTC norms. 11.
- That a computer center with adequate number of terminals, Printers, legal software etc. shall be established as per AICTE norms. 12.
- That a Joint FDR is required to be created for an amount and period prescribed by the Council from time to time. 13.
- AICTE may carry out random inspections round the year any time for verifying the status of the Institutions to ensure maintenance of norms and standards 14
- That the AICTE may also conduct inspections with or without notifying the dates to verify specific complaints of mis-representation, violation of norms and standards, mal-practices etc. 15
- That the Institution by virtue of the approval given by Council shall not automatically become claimant to any grant-in-aid from the Central or State Government.
